

**Community Games Jubilee Raffle (“the Raffle”) is licensed by Longford District Court License issued on Monday August 8<sup>th</sup> 2016.**

1. By entering the Raffle, you agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions. Any Raffle entry and participation instructions form part of these Terms and Conditions. Any entries not complying with these Terms and Conditions will not be valid.
2. The cost of each entry into the Raffle is €10 per ticket
3. 30% payment per ticket for participation in the Raffle must be made by cheque or bank transfer via County Committees to National Community Games. The remaining 70% is kept by the Area selling the ticket and to be used towards Area Jubilee events for 2017.
4. The prize is as described on the Community Games website [www.communitygames.ie/jubilee-raffle](http://www.communitygames.ie/jubilee-raffle) and in promotional material and ticket stubs.
5. The prize is subject to availability and the Promoter reserves the right to substitute any prize with another prize of equal or greater value. Prizes are non-transferable, non-negotiable and no cash alternative will be available. Prizes will be awarded before 31/01/2017.
6. The Promoter reserves the right to modify, cancel, terminate or suspend the Raffle in whole or in part at the Promoter’s sole discretion.
7. The raffle will be launched at the 1<sup>st</sup> weekend of the National Festival in Athlone (12th to 14th August) where each County will be allocated tickets. Extra tickets must be ordered online and extra tickets can only be ordered by County Committee. [Click here](#)
8. Tickets can be requested up until Friday 4th November 2016. Tickets (sold and unsold) must be returned to Head Office by Friday 18th November 2016 in order to be included in the draw. All returns of tickets (sold and unsold) must be returned by County Committee.
9. Tickets returned after this date will not be included in the Draw.
10. The draw will take place on November 26th at the Area, Volunteer and Media Awards in Salthill Hotel, Galway by an independent person.
11. Participation in the Draw is not compulsory.
12. The distribution of tickets to each Area and the reconciliation of tickets returned by each Area will be managed by our online system and staff. All additional tickets must be ordered via the County committee and ticket returns must be managed by County Committee.
13. The Promoter may amend these terms and conditions at any time.
14. Every ticket must be accounted for in accordance with the licence obtained and as such the details of tickets sold by any Area must be entered into the online system. Tickets that are returned but not entered on the online ticket recording system will a) not be entered in the Raffle and b) your Area will not be entered in the Area Incentive Draw\*. All funds raised from the raffle must be reflected in the Areas Annual Accounts.
15. These terms and conditions are governed by Irish law and entrants submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Irish courts.
16. The Promoter’s decision in all matters relating to the Raffle is final.
17. The Promoter is committed to operating the Raffle in a socially responsible way. - c) Accounted for all funds raised in the Area accounts - i.e. the amount shown in Area income should correspond with the total ticket sales amount.
- d) Adhered to all terms and conditions of the Raffle.
